


After all electrical connections have been made; apply power to the VMX-P configured soft starter.

On initial power up, VMX-P will show a 'Setup Wizard' menu – Auto and Advanced. To jump immediately to the pre-defined parameter sets, press the Auto button and follow the on-screen prompts to select your application and set the motor Full Load Amps.

To automatically set up parameters on subsequent start-up, select the 'Home' menu from the status screen and select 'Auto Setup'.

Remote Start / Stop Control connections:


The VMX-P is set up for 2 or 3 wire remote control using dry contacts rated at 120VAC (0.1Amp).

Remote Two Wire Control: Connect a dry (voltage free) maintained contact closure between terminals 1 and 3 of the customer terminal strip as shown below.

Remote Three Wire Control:

For standard 3-wire control, connect dry (voltage free) contacts for the Stop / Start buttons as shown below of the customer terminal strip. Connect the normally closed "STOP" pushbutton across terminals 1 & 2, and the normally open "START" pushbutton across terminals 2 & 3 of the customer terminal strip.

Note: the unit can be operated in the "Local" position without any external control.

Status LED

The Motortronics logo LED located on the front panel of the VMX-P will blink once every 10 seconds to provide visual confirmation that all microprocessors in the soft starter are operating properly.

Setup by Individual Parameter Settings


Allows the user to change parameter settings one at a time. The individual parameters are grouped by categories on the touchscreen.


Configuration from the Touchscreen
